

New District Director for ACBL District 1

In an uncontested election, Leo Weniger has been elected as District Director, replacing George Retek who has stepped down after representing the District for 33 years. George succeeded Henri Parent who was District Director for over 20 years. Leo's 3 year term will start in January.

Leo is the first resident of the Atlantic Provinces to represent the District which is made up of the Atlantic Provinces, Quebec and Eastern Ontario. He will be one of 26 Directors on the ACBL Board. ACBL governs bridge in Canada, the United States, Bermuda and Mexico. He will also serve ex-officio on the District 1 and Canadian Bridge Federation boards. The District governs ACBL bridge matters in the District including responsibility for sanctioning regionals and special games such as NAP and GNT. The District is made up of 6 units, including the Acadian Unit 230 and Maritime Unit 194.

Leo has served as District President for over 20 years, a position now held by Peter Clark. Before that he was Vice-President of the District, and many years ago was Vice president of Unit 230. He also was Co-Chair with Mary (Moulton) Balkam of the combined CBF Bridge Week and CanAt in Halifax in 2000.

George Retek served the District effectively and conscientiously, serving as ACBL President in 2002, the year that he was instrumental in having the World Championships in Montreal. He also served as ACBL Treasurer. He has also represented the ACBL on the World Bridge Federation board, serving as Vice-president and Treasurer and he is currently Honorary Secretary. We thank George for all his efforts in the past and wish him well in the future.
